It covers participation in opening and closing ceremonies, delegate kits, participation certificates, incentives to winners, socials and entrance to the two-day conference.

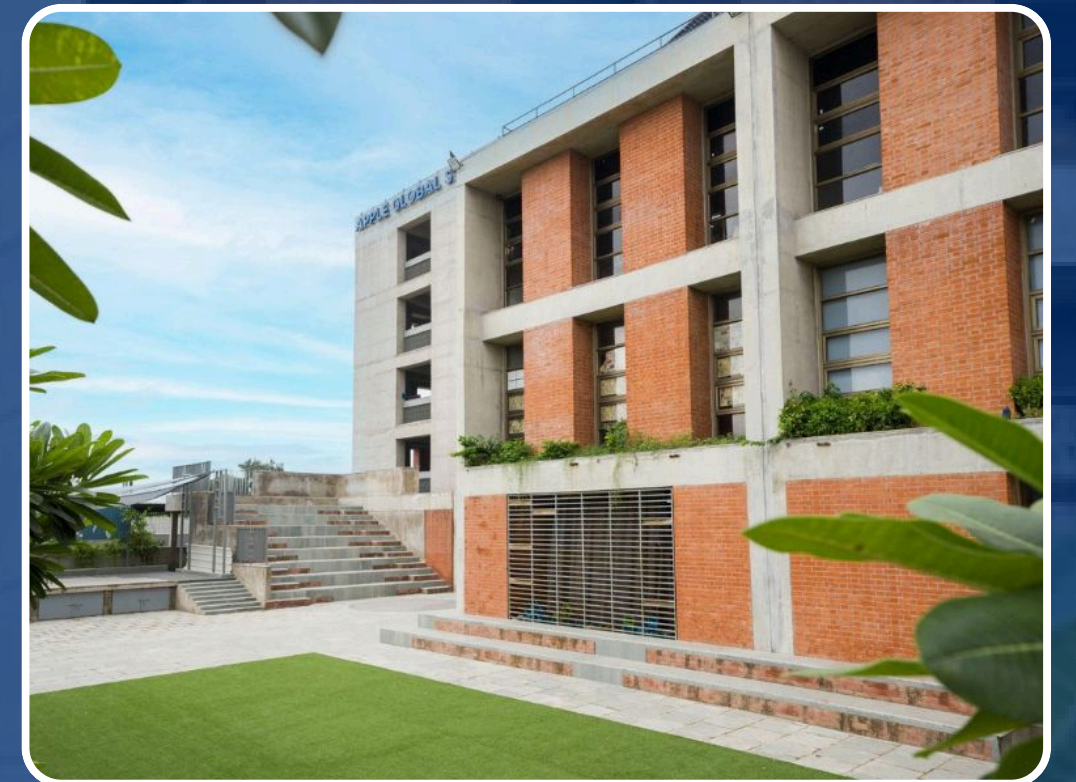
